## **FALCON MOTOR CLUB** **September Surprise Autotest** **Sunday 4<sup>th</sup> September 2005**

### Additional Supplementary Regulations

- 1 The Falcon Motor Club will organise a duel permit Clubsport / Production Car Autotest on 4<sup>th</sup> September 2005 at The Node Farm, Codicote, Herts. Map Ref 166/216197
- 2 The meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of the Motor Sport Association Ltd (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FISA), the Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions that the organising Club may issue for the event.
- 3 MSA Permits have been applied for.
- 4 The event is open to all fully elected members of the Falcon Motor Club, and Chemsford Motor Club.
- 5 All competitors must produce a valid membership card, valid MOT certificate and insurance (Production Car event only).
- 6 The programme of the meeting will be: Scrutineering starts at 10.00am (any competitor not signed on by 10.45am may be excluded).  
The first car will start at 11.00am
- 7 **The Clubsport** event will consist of five classes as follows:
  - A) Engine over driven wheels up to 3744 mm long (12' 3"<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>).
  - B) Engine over driven wheels over 3744 mm long (12' 3"<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>).
  - C) Front engine rear wheel drive saloons of any length.
  - D) Sports cars, kit cars and specials.Overall length to include bumpers whether fitted or not.  
  
**The Production Car** event will consist of two classes as follows:
  - P1) Competitor's aged 14,15,16 years of age and those who do not hold a full RTA licence (B 8.3.5). The passenger must hold a full RTA licence and be experienced in Autotesting (F 9.2.1). Attention is drawn to B 9.3.8. A Parent or guardian must countersign the entry form of a competitor who is under 18 years of age.
  - P2) Drivers over 17 years of age competing with a passenger.  
All cars competing in the Production Class must be, saloon cars as defined in General Regulations F9.2.2. They must conform to F 12.4, be registered taxed and insured and have a valid MOT certificate.
- 8 All cars must comply with the Technical Regulations. Except the following which has been modified: F 11.8.1 need not be registered or taxed. (Except for class P)
- 8a Your attention is drawn to the following regulations:  
F 11.5 (E12.17), F 11.6 (Q1.5.1),

- 9 Awards will be presented as follows and will be perpetual.  
FTD  
First in Class  
Second in Class (subject to 4 starters)  
Third in Class (subject to 6 starters)  
Best Novice (subject to 3 starters)  
Awards will be presented at the end of the event following publication of the results.
- 10 The entry list opens on the publication of these regulations and closes on Sunday 4<sup>th</sup> September 2005. The entry fee is £14.00 if received by Wednesday 31<sup>st</sup> August 2005. £18.00 if received after Wednesday 31<sup>st</sup> August 2005.
- NOTE: A full refund will be given if entry is withdrawn up to the day before the event (before 9pm). All entries must be made on the official entry form completed in full and accompanied by the appropriate fee.

- 15 Any protest must be lodged in accordance as laid down in the Motor Sports Association competitors Yearbook 2005.
- 16 a) Details of tests will be issued at signing on.  
b) Each driver will have two runs, best time to count.  
c) Timing will be by hand held watch.  
d) Starting signal will be verbal.  
e) Order of attempting tests will be consecutive.
- 17 Practising will not be allowed.
- 18 All other General Regulations of the MSA apply as written except, that as the event takes place on private land, and Pylons may be less than 1 meter high.
- 19 Marking and penalties will be as printed in the General Regulations.
- 20 A car may be entered more than once in the same class provided that it is driven by different drivers on each occasion
- 21 Toilet facilities will be available on site.
